



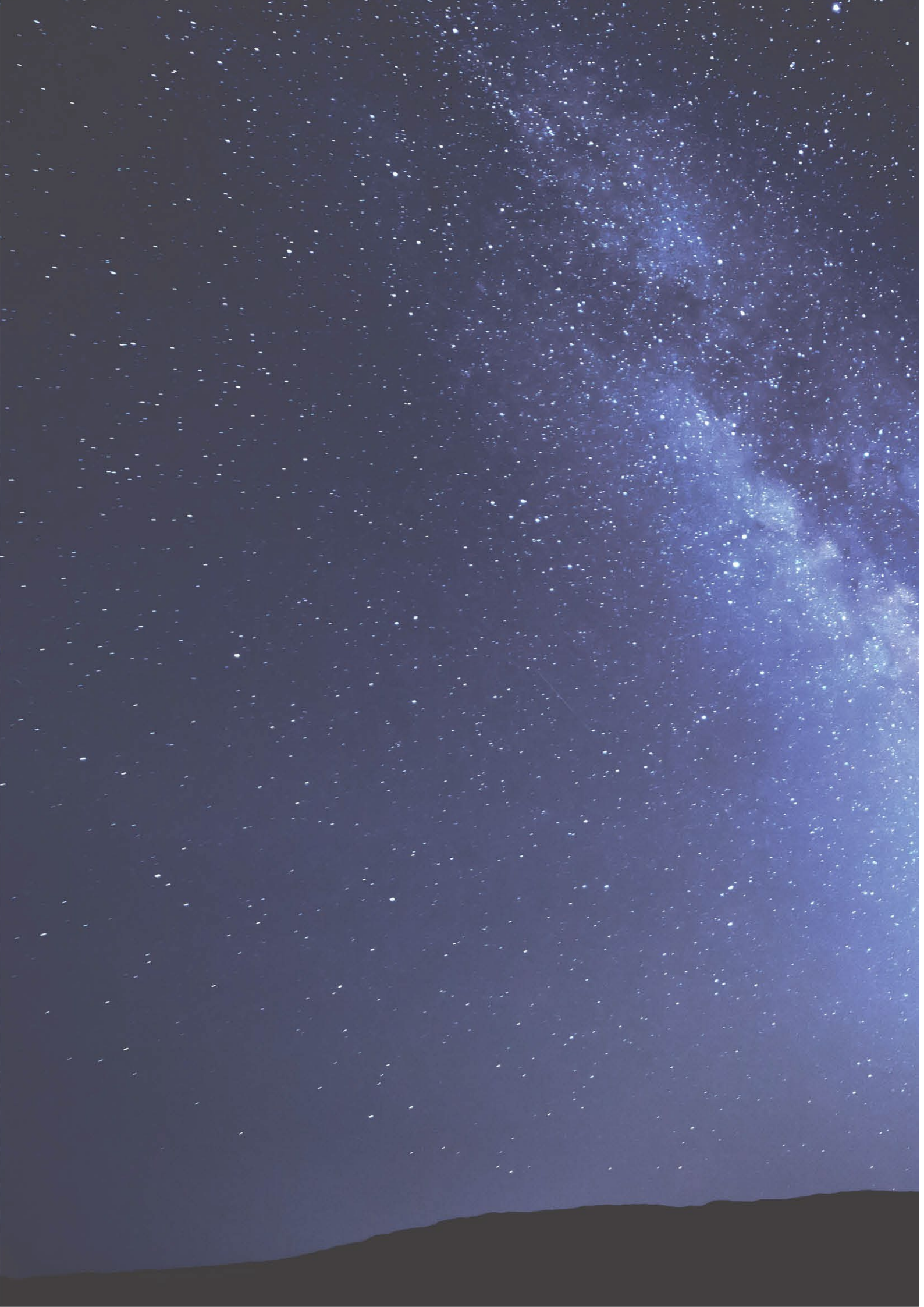

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report is D1.1 of the PEERS project entitled "Data Management Plan". Its objective is to recommend mechanisms for capturing, storing, and managing data in relation to a Data Management Plan for the PEERS project.

This report describes the overall data management in the project, including the lifecycle of data to be collected, generated, used, or processed within the project and the handling of data, including methodologies, data sharing, privacy and security considerations, legal and regulatory requirements, informed consent, open access, for during and after the project. The report also describes the main data types and structures of the project, operational and observational data, simulation data, compiled data and meta data.

This report highlights the ethical compliance mechanisms in the project to safeguard data and the ethical requirements of the project in relation to data privacy and security. It also outlines the procedures in place in terms of internal data management structures and administration.
