## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This deliverable aims to provide an overview of the main points discussed from November 2022 to December 2023 with the PEERS Co-Creation Group, which at present gathers 104 members from 18 EU Member States, Israel, Norway, Turkey, UK and the US, who provided us with feedback about the PEERS activities and concept.

The analysis made has been the final outcome of the round table and open discussions, bilateral meetings, polls and interviews that have been exploited by PEERS to gather important feedback and increase the acceptance of the PEERS ecosystem from the Co-Creation Group’s perspective, with the aim to make PEERS an important tool in upskilling its target stakeholders and enhancing the EU resilience against CBRN-E threats through pre-normative / standardisation processes.

They have been instrumental for the implementation of the PEERS co-creation process, as part of the work instilled in Work Package 3, which will be further capitalised to deliver the Gamma version of the ecosystem by the end of the project. According to this, this document is the first of a set of iterative versions that will be made available in M28 - February 2025 (i.e., D6.9 - Report on the Cluster Community Group’s feedback on PEERS, its activities and ecosystem (version 2) and M36 – October 2025 (i.e., D6.10 - Report on the Cluster Community Group’s feedback on PEERS, its activities and ecosystem (version 3)), respectively.
