EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Deliverable 5.2 describes the Integration of the Demonstrator results into the PEERS ecosystem. This task sought to deploy the outcomes of the Demonstrators elsewhere in the project to facilitate technical advancements to the PEERS ecosystem. All partners and the External Complementary Board members formed part of the Demonstrator Group.

The participants in Work Package 5 worked under the leadership and direction of RAN who were responsible for identifying and deploying the appropriate resources described. FIPRA were responsible for adding depth and detail to the Demonstrators in respect of NATO Standards. FORMIT were active in relation to Public Procurement experts. TFC provided in depth knowledge of existing standards and processes and UoG and TFC ensured compatibility with WP2, WP3 and WP4 tasks.

Throughout the practice and development phase of the platform, Subject Matter experts provided critical feedback to the project supporting the system and demonstrators to be “demonstration ready”. This included a total of 9 rehearsals which systematically refined the approach and proved crucial to the success of the events. The practitioner-focused approach throughout the Demonstrators encouraged broad interest and critical feedback, which will now be fed back into the project through the processes described in T5.3. This will be critical in ensuring that the PEERS platform continues to evolve and deliver the strengthening of preparedness and response in the field of DRR and CBRNe through standardisation.

The project is not well-placed to deal with all aspects of confidentiality arising from deployment of the CBRNe Knowledge Hub. It is anticipated that “Sensitive” documents will be dealt with by the hoped-for data repository, the Disaster Risk Stakeholder Hub moving forward.
