EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This deliverable provides an overview of key discussions held between January 2024 and January 2025 with the PEERS Co-Creation Group. This group included policymakers, CBRN-E practitioners, researchers, and representatives from industry and standardisation bodies across the EU and beyond, that provided valuable feedback on the PEERS activities and concept.

The analysis presented in this document is result of a series of Meeting of Mind events centred on the Beta version of the PEERS ecosystem (referred to as the “CBRN-E Knowledge Hub” as part of the project's exploitation and sustainability strategy), including webinars, joint-project events involving round table sessions, open discussions, bilateral meetings, polls, questionnaires and interviews. These efforts further enabled PEERS to gather critical insights, increasing the acceptance of the CBRN-E Knowledge Hub. The goal is to establish the CBRN-E Knowledge Hub as an essential tool for upskilling its target stakeholders and enhancing the EU resilience against CBRN-E threats through pre-normative and standardisation processes.

The Co-Creation Group’s input was critical in shaping the PEERS ecosystem and reassuring the design of the Hub, as part of Work Package 3. This feedback, combined with the legacy from the Demonstrator Groups held in Work Package 5, will be used to further advance the Gamma version of the CBRN-E Knowledge Hub, which is expected to be released by August 2025. This document represents the second of three iterative versions to be released by M36 (i.e., October 2025), with the final version (D6.10) titled “Report on the Cluster Community Group’s feedback on PEERS, its activities and ecosystem (version 3).”
